Recognition of "The Society of the War of 1812 in the State of Iowa"

As President General of the General Society of the War of 1812, it is my pleasure to inform you, "The General Society of the War of 1812", at the Triennial Meeting, Charleston, SC 17 September 2011, voted by Acclimation to approve recognition of the "**Society of the War of 1812 in the State of Iowa**".

Primary Resident Membership requirement

This approval was granted based on your submission of a minimum of Ten (10) Primary Resident members, and Iowa has met this requirement. **The List is attached below.**

Applications:

A key item is that Iowa is now authorized to verify the genealogy of the Applicant. The only requirement is that you send the verified Application (no proofs) with State Number and \$12.00 (payable to "The General Society of the War of 1812", to the Registrar General Christos Christou, for the final approval and assignment of the General Society Number. For Applications submitted after Sep 1, the \$12 is paid for the following year.

Per Capita and Annual Report:

The Annual Reports are due between 1Jan11 and 31Jan11. For those received and verified, the Treasurer will refund \$2 per member when he completes his review. Our Treasurer General Thomas E. Jacks has been provided the names you submitted to me, and he will be able to issue the 2011 Membership List with Per Capita assignment direct to Indiana. An additional requirement for continued recognition per Article 5 Section 4, is "The State Societies shall meet annually".

Charter Period

You may have an "Open Charter Period", so the "Potential" members can when their Application Process is complete become Charter members. You indicated you have one more Application to process. Keep us posted so we can advise the Secretary General when to have the Charter Prepared. Following that, we can arrange a Charter Presentation.

We are all very pleased at having a Society of the War of 1812 in Iowa.
